'RECRUITMENT OF CONSTABLE/ DRIVERS IN C.R.P.F.'

1. Recruitment for the posts of Constable/Drivers on all India basis will be carried out at 89 Bn, CRPF, Bawana, New Delhi for Male candidates only wef. 17/05/2010:-

Note: Number of vacancies are liable to be changed / altered without assigning any reason.

2. The post carries pay scale of Pay Band - 1 i.e. Rs. 5200-20200 with grade pay of Rs. 2000/-.
3. Other Allowances :- As admissible to Central Government Employees from time to time under the rules.
4. Place of duty :- Any where within as well as outside the Territory of India.
5. There is no restriction of domiciliary status for recruitment of above posts.
6. The recruitment is on All India Basis.
7. New Contributory Pension scheme to Central Govt. employees which has come into effect from 01/01/2004 will be applicable to all selected candidates.
8. Ward (s) of serving CRPF personnel may also apply, if so desired accordingly. They will be required to compete with common candidates. Wards of CRPF serving personnel / died/ invalidated out from service should have an undertaking to be issued by the concerned GCs/BNs that the candidate who has appeared for recruitment is a CRPF Ward by giving full details about the Govt. servant to avoid any bogus entry in the recruitment.

9. **RELAXATION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN**

The following relaxations are applicable in the matter for recruitment of Ex-servicemen in CRPF:-

- a) Physical standard : Total relaxation.
- b) Educational Qualification : Total relaxation.

- c) Character certificate : Minimum requirement will be "good" category.
- d) Medical Standard : Shape - I
- e) Relaxation of upper age limit: Relaxation to the extent of military service plus 3 years as provided in DOPT notification No. 3016 / 10 / 79 - Estt. I dated 15/12/79. Break between Army service and date of re-employment in CRPF should not exceed 24 months.
- f) No Physical Efficiency Test will be held for Ex-servicemen at the time of their recruitment in CRPF. However, Ex-servicemen will be required to appear in written examination & medical examination.

10. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR CT/DRIVER ARE AS UNDER:**

- A) **Education Qualification** Matriculation or 10th class pass from recognized Board / University.
- Technical qualification** Candidates for the post of CT/Driver should be in possession of valid MT heavy Driving License (HTV) and should pass the driving test at the time of recruitment.
- B) **Age** Between 18 to 23 Years as on 1/8/2009
- Relaxation**
- a) Upper age limit is relaxable up to 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates.
- b) The children and dependent family members of those who killed in the riots of 1984 would be eligible for relaxation in age by 5 years. If the applicant belongs to SC/ST or OBC category, the relaxation so provided in this clause will be in addition to the age relaxation as applicable in (a) above. To obtain this relaxation a certificate from the concerned District Magistrate of the district where the victim was killed, should be attached with the application.
- C) **Medical Standard**
- a) **Eye Sight :-**
- i) The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of 2 eyes without correction i.e. without wearing of glasses.
- ii) Should be free from colour blindness.
- b) The candidates must not have knock knee, stammering, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defects likely to interfere with the efficiency performance of the duties.

D). **PHYSICAL STANDARD**

- a) Height For male candidates- 170 Cms.
Relaxation
 Minimum Height of male candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh region of J&K will be 165 Cms. The minimum height for all male candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes will be 162.5 Cms.
- b) Chest Un-expanded - 80 Cms, Expanded - 85 Cms
 (Minimum expansion 5 Cms.)
Relaxation
 Minimum chest of male candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh region of J&K will be 78 Cms (Minimum expansion 5 Cms). The minimum chest for all male candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes will be 76 Cms (Minimum expansion 5 Cms).
- c) Weight Proportionate to height and age as per Medical standard.

11. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**

No application is required to be submitted in this regard. The recruitment shall be on open rally system. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board on the date prescribed above. Candidates will have to undergo the following test:

a) **HEIGHT BAR**

At the very beginning, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

b) **5 Kms Race (Qualifying Nature)**

Those candidates who qualify the height bar will be subjected to 5 Kms race to be completed in 24 minutes.

Note:-

The candidate (s) who will not qualify the 5 Kms race will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

c) **Identification of candidate**

The candidates who have qualified the 5 Kms race will be subjected to the modern biometrics methods at each stage of recruitment to obviate impersonation by the candidates. (In the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression digital photograph, and any specifying identifying mark in the body will be used).

d) **Screening of testimonials**

Original testimonial/documents of the candidates will be checked after the identification process is completed and only eligible candidates will be permitted to the next stage of the recruitment. Candidates failed to produce the requisite testimonials/certificates should be eliminated from the recruitment process and in no case candidates should be allowed provisionally.

e) **Physical Measurement**

The candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened for height, chest and weight by the board of officers. The candidates who meet the requirement of physical standard will be allowed to participate in Physical Efficiency Test and candidates who do not fulfill the laid down physical standard will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection. Any dispute in measurement will be settled by the Presiding Officer on the Spot whose order will be final.

f) **Physical Efficiency Test**

The Physical Efficiency Test will consist of following qualifying nature events:-

- i) 11 feet long jump (3 chances will be given).
- ii) 3.5 feet high jump (3 chances will be given).

Note:-

A candidate must qualify in the above events. Failure to qualify in any of the above events of PET will render the candidate disqualified to appear in subsequent process of the recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

g) **Trade Test**

The candidate who qualifies in the P.E.T. will be tested in trade/job efficiency by Board of Officers.

h) **Written Examination (100 Marks)**

- i) The candidates who are found proficient in trade will be required to appear in a Written Test.
- ii) The written test will be of one hour 30 minutes duration and comprise of two parts with a maximum of 100 Marks, where in 50 Marks will be allotted for descriptive test viz essay/letter writing of about 100 words in Hindi or English and descriptive questions to test General Awareness and environment and remaining 50 Marks for objective test consisting of questions based on General knowledge, Science, Numerical Aptitude, Test of reasoning etc.
- iii) The question paper will consist of questions on General Awareness, General Knowledge, Knowledge of elementary Mathematics, ability to observe and distinguish pattern and to test the basic knowledge of candidate in English/Hindi. The paper can be answered either in Hindi or English. The written test will be held after Trade test.
- iv) Answer should be marked / written with Ball Pen only.

i) **Medical Examination**

- i) Candidates who qualified in PET/ PST and Written Test and find place in the merit list will be put through detailed Medical Examination to assess their suitability / fitness for appointment.

Note :- Candidates equal to the number of vacancies in each category and normal anticipated failures as per the past experience are to be called for medical examination. Even, there is a shortfall, no further round of medical examination will be conducted. Unfilled vacancies will be remained as shortfall.

ii) **Appeal against medical examination**

In case of medical examination, "Temporary Unfitness" will not be allowed. A candidate declared unfit for appointment in CRPF in detailed medical examination will be communicated the grounds for rejection in broad terms by Presiding Officer of the recruitment board. The candidate if not satisfied with the finding of the Medical Officer can submit an appeal for re-medical examination with a proof of his fitness in the form of a medical certificate as given in **Annexure-IV**. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit by a Medical officer for appointment in CRPF. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee of Rs. 25/- (Rupees twenty five only) through crossed IPO/Bank Draft/Banker's cheque in the name of the Appellate Authority i.e. DIGP Group Centre CRPF, Jharoda Kalan, New Delhi and the same should be submitted within 15 days from the date of

issue of the communication in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate.

j) **Final Selection**

Final selection of the candidate will be made in order of merit in each category as per cut off percentage of marks as under:-

General	-	35 %
SC/ST/OBC	-	33 %

The following documents in original should be brought by the candidate at the time of recruitment:-

- i) Matriculation (SSLC) certificate for proof of Educational qualification and Date of Birth.
- ii) SC/ST and OBC certificate, as applicable, issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar which should be on the format as prescribed in Annexure-I & II respectively.
- iii) Original Technical/Trade/Professional and experience certificates.
- iv) Discharge certificate in case of Ex – Servicemen.
- v) Other certificates in support of additional qualification i.e. NCC/Scout & guides/sports/proficiency in computer if any.
- vi) No objection certificate in case of persons serving in Govt. Departments/Semi Government Departments /Undertakings etc.
- vii) Four recent passport size photographs.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- i) Candidates will have to appear for selection/test at their own expenses and no TA/DA will be admissible. They will also have to make their own arrangements for stay during recruitment. Candidates are advised to bring their own pen/pencil etc.
- ii) The Department will not be responsible for any accident/injuries if any, sustained during the course of test/recruitment.
- iii) Selected candidates on their appointment in CRPF will be governed by the CRPF Act 1949, CRPF Rules 1955 and other Central Government Rules and regulations as applicable from time to time.
- iv) All the posts are combatised and are purely temporary but likely to be continued. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India or outside.
- v) Canvassing in any form or bringing outside influence will automatically disqualify the candidate from appearing the tests.
- vi) Vacancies can be altered/changed/increased /decreased due to administrative reasons.
- vii) Domiciliary Status: - On All India basis.

14. IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES

- i) The recruitment process has a 5 Km run to be completed in 24 minutes. This requires endurance and stamina. Candidates are advised to practice for the races before coming for recruitment. they are further advised to get themselves medically examined regarding their suitability to run the specified distance in the given time. CRPF will not be responsible for any injury/ mishap or medical problem which may arise from the race or other events of the recruitment process.
- ii) Be aware of Touts. No money is charged for recruitment in CRPF. If you have paid or promised to pay money to any one, you are cheated, you are losing money. If anyone demands money or promise recruitment, immediately inform the Presiding Officer (P.O.) of recruitment Board.

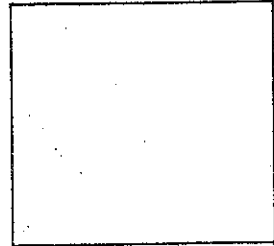
