'RECRUITMENT OF "CT/ DRIVER" IN C.R.P.F.'

Recruitment for posts of Constable (Driver) on all India basis will be carried out at **Group Centre, C.R.P.F., Campus, Lucknow** for Male candidates only wef **07/06/2010**.

The Registration of candidates & issue of registration slips will be held on only on 07/06/2010 from 0900 hrs to 1800 hrs at Group Centre, CRPF, Lucknow

2. The Pay Scale for the above post is PB-1Rs. 5200-20200 and Grade pay Rs. 2000/- p.m.
3. **Other allowances** : As admissible to Central Govt. employees from time to time under the rules.
4. **Place of duty** : Any where within as well as outside the Territory of India.
5. There is no restriction of domiciliary status for recruitment of above posts.
6. The recruitment is on All India Basis.
7. New Contributory Pension scheme to Central Govt. employees which has come into effect from 01/01/2004 will be applicable to all selected candidates.
8. Ward (s) of serving CRPF personnel may also apply, if so desired accordingly. They will be required to compete with common candidates. Wards of CRPF serving personnel / died/ invalidated out from service should have an undertaking to be issued by the concerned GCs/BNs that the candidate who has appeared for recruitment is a CRPF Ward by giving full details about the Govt. servant to avoid any bogus entry in the recruitment.

9. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR RE EMPLOYMENT OF EX SERVICEMEN :-**

Ex servicemen being trained soldier, only written test, interview and medical fitness test to ascertain medical category will be conducted. As per Govt. orders total relaxation in prescribed physical standards and education is admissible. No PET is required for Ex servicemen. Other conditions are as under :-

- A) Ex-servicemen means a person, who has served in any rank whether as a combatant or non-combatant in the regular Army, Navy and Air Force of the Indian Union but does not include a person who has served in the Defence Security Corps, the Central Reserve Engineering Force, the Lok-Sahayak Sewa and the Para Military Forces and,
- i. Who has retired from such service after earning his pension: or
 - ii. Who has been released, otherwise than on his own request from such service as a result of reduction in establishment: or
 - iii. Who has been released from Service after completing the specific period of engagement otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharge on account of misconduct or inefficiency and has been given gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following Categories namely :
 - i) Pension holders or continuous (embodied) service
 - ii) Gallantry award winners
- B) The territorial Army personnel who fulfill above conditions will be treated a Ex-servicemen with effect from 15/11/1986.
- C) The above revised definition of 1986 would be applicable to those service personnel who are released from service w.e.f 01/07/1987.

- 1) **Education** : Total relaxation
- 2) **Physical Standard** : Total relaxation
- 3) **Medical standard** : Shape - One
- 4) **Break in Service** : Not more than 24 months.

- 5) **Age limit** : Age concession for Ex-servicemen will be allowed in accordance with the orders issued by the Govt. of India from time to time and they will be allowed to deduct military service from their actual age and such resultant age should not exceed the prescribed age limit by more than 3 years.
- 6) **Character** : Should be exemplary/Very Good /Good

E) ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR CT/Driver ARE AS UNDER:

- A) **Age** : 18-23 years (cut off date for age will be 1st Aug. 2009)
- i) Relaxation in upper age limit as under :-

SC/ST	- 5 years
OBC	- 3 years
 - ii) 5 years of age relaxation in addition to above will be granted to the Children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots as per Govt. of India, MHA UO No. I.45023/2/2007/Pers.II dated 21/09/2007. To avail the relaxation the candidate (i.e.) children/ dependent family members of those killed in the riots has to produce a certificate from the concerned district collector.

B) **Educational Qualification :**

- i) Matriculation or 10th class pass from a recognized board.

Technical qualification :

- i) Candidates should be in possession of valid MT Heavy Driving License (HTV) and should pass the driving test at the time of recruitment.

C) **Physical Standards :-**

- i) Height :- Min. 170 CMS
ii) Weight :- Proportionate to height as per medical standards.
iii) Chest :- Un - expanded 80 Cms, Expanded 85 Cms.

D) Medical Standard:-

- a. Eye Sight : Distant Vision :-
Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 & 6/9 of two eyes without correction I.e, without wearing of glasses.
- b. The Candidates must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint eyes, Colour blind and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily healthy and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

E) Relaxation :

Height:- The minimum height of candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh regions of J&K will be 165 Cms. The minimum height of all candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes will be 162.5 Cms.

Chest :- The minimum chest of male candidates falling in the categories of Gharwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh regions of J&K will be 78 Cms (minimum 5 Cms expansion). The minimum chest for all male candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes will be 76 Cms (minimum 5 Cms expansion). For relaxation in height and chest Annexure - III is attached)

11. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**

No application is required to be submitted in this regard. The recruitment shall be on open rally system. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board on the dates and time prescribed above. Candidates will have to undergo the following test :

a) **HEIGHT BAR**

At the very beginning, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

b) **5 Kms Race (Qualifying Nature)**

Those candidates who qualify the height bar will be subjected to 5 Kms race to be completed in 24 minutes.

Note:-

The candidate (s) who will not qualify the 5 Kms race will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

c) **Identification of candidate**

The candidates who have qualified the 5 Kms race will be subjected to the modern biometrics methods at each stage of recruitment to obviate impersonation by the candidates. (In the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression digital photograph, and any specifying identifying mark in the body will be used).

d) **Screening of testimonials**

Original testimonial/documents of the candidates will be checked after the identification process is completed and only eligible candidates will be permitted to the next stage of the recruitment. Candidates failed to produce the requisite testimonials/certificates should be eliminated from the recruitment process and in no case candidates should be allowed provisionally.

e) **Physical Measurement**

The candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened for height, chest and weight by the board of officers. The candidates who meet the requirement of physical standard will be allowed to participate in Physical Efficiency Test and candidates who do not fulfill the laid down physical standard will be eliminated for participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection. Any dispute in measurement will be settled by the Presiding Officer on the Spot whose order will be final.

f) **Physical Efficiency Test**

The Physical Efficiency Test will consist of following qualifying nature events:-

- i) 11 feet long jump (3 chances will be given).
- ii) 3.5 feet high jump (3 chances will be given).

Note:-

A candidate must qualify in the above events. Failure to qualify in any of the above events of PET will render the candidate disqualified to appear in subsequent process of the recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

g) **Trade Test**

The candidate who qualifies in the P.E.T. will be tested in their respective trades/job efficiency by a Board of Officers.

h) **Written Examination (100 Marks)**

- i) The candidates who are found proficient in their respective trade will be required to appear in a Written Test.
- ii) The written test will be of one hour 30 minutes duration and comprise of two parts with a maximum of 100 Marks, where in 50 Marks will be allotted for de-

scriptive test viz essay/letter writing of about 100 words in Hindi or English and descriptive questions to test General Awareness and environment and remaining 50 Marks for objective test consisting of questions based on General knowledge, Science, Numerical Aptitude, Test of reasoning etc.

iii) The question paper will consist of questions on General Awareness, General Knowledge, Knowledge of elementary Mathematics, ability to observe and distinguish pattern and to test the basic knowledge of candidate in English/Hindi. The paper can be answered either in Hindi or English. The written test will be held after Trade test.

iv) Answer should be marked / written with Ball Pen only.

i) **Medical Examination**

i) Candidates who qualified in PET, Written Test and find place in the merit list will be put through detailed Medical Examination to assess their suitability / fitness for appointment.

Note :- Candidates equal to the number of vacancies in each category and normal anticipated failures as per the past experience are to be called for medical examination. Even, there is a shortfall, no further round of medical examination will be conducted. Unfilled vacancies will be remained as shortfall.

ii) **Appeal against medical examination**

In case of medical examination, **“Temporary Unfitness”** will not be allowed. A candidate declared unfit for appointment in CRPF in detailed medical examination will be communicated the grounds for rejection in broad terms by Presiding Officer of the recruitment board. The candidate if not satisfied with the finding of the Medical Officer can submit an appeal for re-medical examination with a proof of his fitness in the form of a medical certificate as given in **Annexure-III**. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit by a Medical officer for appointment in CRPF. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee of Rs. 25/- (Rupees twenty five only) through crossed IPO/Bank Draft/Banker's cheque in the name of the **Appellate Authority i.e. DIG, Group Centre, CRPF, Lucknow (UP)** and the same should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate.

I) **FINAL SELECTION :-**

i. The final selection of the candidate will be made in order of merit in each category.

.ii The cut off percentage of marks for appointment will be as under:-

General and Ex servicemen	: 35 %
SC/ST/OBC	: 33 %

iii. There will not be any interview for this recruitment.

12. The following documents in original should be brought by the candidate at the time of recruitment:-
- i) Matriculation(SSLC) certificate for proof of Educational qualification and Date of Birth.
 - ii) SC/ST and OBC certificate, as applicable, issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar which should be on the format as prescribed in Annexure-I & II respectively.
 - iii) Original Technical / Professional and experience certificates.
 - iv) Discharge certificate in case of Ex - Servicemen
 - v) Other certificates in support of additional qualification i.e. NCC/Scout & guides / sports / proficiency in computer if any.
 - vi) No objection certificate in case of persons serving in Govt. Departments/Semi Government Departments /Undertakings etc.
 - vii) Four recent passport size photographs.
13. **General Conditions :-**
- i) Candidates will have to appear for selection/test at their own expenses and no TA/DA will be admissible. They will also have to make their own arrangements for stay during recruitment. Candidates are advised to bring their own pen/pencil etc.
 - ii) The Department will not be responsible for any accident/injuries if any, sustained during the course of test/recruitment.
 - iii) Selected candidates on their appointment in CRPF will be governed by the CRPF Act 1949, CRPF Rules 1955 and other Central Government Rules and regulations as applicable from time to time.
 - iv) All the posts are combatised and are purely temporary but likely to be continued. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India or outside.
 - v) Canvassing in any form or bringing outside influence will automatically disqualify the candidate from appearing the tests.
 - vi) No prior application is required to be submitted in this regard. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board at **Group Centre, CRPF, Lucknow (UP) Campus.** Vacancies can be altered/changed/increased /decreased due to administrative reasons.
 - vii) Domiciliary Status : - On All India basis.

- Note:-** i) Be aware of Touts. No money is charged for recruitment in CRPF. If you have paid or promised to pay money to any one, you are cheated, you are losing money. If any one demands money or promise recruitment, immediately inform the Presiding Officer (PO) of recruitment board.
- ii) Undergoing Medical Examination at the end of all test and qualifying in the same does not guarantee appointment as the offer of appointment will be issued only according to allotted vacancies from the category wise merit list.

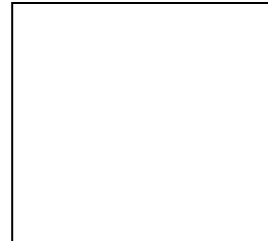
