'RECRUITMENT OF CONSTABLE/DRIVERS IN C.R.P.F.'

1. Recruitment for the posts of Constable/Drivers on **all India basis** will be carried out at **Group Centre, CRPF, Pinjore, Distt Panchkula, Haryana w.e.f. 24/05/2010 TO 15/06/2010** for Male candidates only.

- Note :-** (i) **Number of Vacancies released/notified may vary later on administrative grounds without assigning any reason.**
(ii) **The Registration of candidates and issue of registration slips for all above posts will be held w.e.f. 24/05/2010 to 26/05/2010 from 0900 hrs to 1700 hrs at Group Centre, CRPF, Pinjore, Distt. Panchkula, Haryana.**
(iii) **Vacancies reserved for Ex-Servicemen under General category will be filled up by fresh candidate, if suitable Ex-Servicemen do not turn up, as per the Ex-Servicemen (Re-employment in Central Civil Services and Posts) Rule 1979.**

2. The post carries pay scale of Pay Band-1 i.e. Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade pay Rs. 2000/- p.m.
3. **Other allowances** :- As admissible to Central Govt. employees from time to time under the rules.
4. **Place of duty :** Any where within as well as outside the Territory of India.
5. There is no restriction of domiciliary status for recruitment of above posts. The recruitment is on All India Basis.
6. New Contributory Pension scheme to Central Govt. employees which has come into effect from 01/01/2004 will be applicable to all selected candidates.
7. Ward (s) of serving CRPF personnel may also appear, if so desire accordingly. They will be required to compete with common candidates. Ward(s) of serving CRPF personnel may appear either from their home State or from the State in which his father/mother is posted/deployed at the time of recruitment. The Wards of CRPF serving personnel will produce an undertaking to be issued by the

concerned GCs/BNs that the candidate who has appeared for recruitment is a CRPF ward by giving full details about the Govt. Servant to avoid any bogus entry in the recruitment.

8. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR CT/DRIVER ARE AS UNDER:

A) Educational Qualification :

- i) Matriculation or 10th class passed from a recognized board/university.

Technical qualification :

- ii) The candidates for the post of CT/Driver should be in possession of valid MT Heavy Driving License (HTV) and should pass the driving test at the time of recruitment.

B) Age : 18–23 years (cut off date for age will be 1st Aug. 2009)

- i) Relaxation in upper age limit as under :-

SC/ST	- 5 years
OBC	- 3 years

- ii) 5 years of age relaxation will be granted to the Children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots as per Govt. of India, MHA UO No. I.45023/2/2007/Pers.II dated 21/09/2007. If the applicant belongs to SC/ST or OBC category, the relaxation so provided in this clause will be in addition to the age relaxation as applicable in (i) above. To avail the relaxation the candidate (i.e.) children/ dependent family members of those killed in the riots has to produce a certificate from the concerned District Magistrate.

C) Physical Standards :-

- (i) **Height : 170 Cms.**

Minimum height of male candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh regions of J & K will be 165 cms. The minimum height for all candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes will be 162.5 cms.

- (ii) **Chest : Un-expanded 80 Cms : Expanded 85 Cms.
(Minimum expansion 5 Cms is required)**

The minimum chest of male candidates falling in the categories of Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Gorkhas, Dogras, Marathas and candidates belonging to the States of Sikkim, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Kashmir and Leh & Ladakh region of J & K will be 78 Cms

(minimum 5 cms expansion). The minimum chest for all male candidates belonging to Schedule Tribes will be 76 cms (minimum 5 cms expansion)

(iii) Weight : Proportionate to height and age as per medical standards.

D) Medical Standard:-

- i) Eye Sight : Distant Vision.
The Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 & 6/9 in both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses and candidate should be free from colour blindness.
- ii) The candidates must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eye and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defects which is likely to interfere with efficient performance of the duties.

E) RELAXATION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN

The following relaxations are applicable in the matter for recruitment of Ex-Servicemen in CRPF.

- (a) Physical Standard : Total relaxation
- (b) Educational Qualification : Total relaxation
- (c) Character Certificate : Minimum requirement will be 'Good' category
- (d) Medical Standard : Shape-I
- (e) Relaxation of upper age Limit: Relaxation to the extent of military service plus 3 years as provided in DOPT Notification No. 3016/10/79-Estt-I dated 15/12/1979. Break between Army Service and date of re-employment in CRPF should not exceed 24 Months,
- (f) No Physical Efficiency Test will be held for Ex-Servicemen at the time of their recruitment in CRPF. However, Ex-Servicemen will be required to appear in written examination & Medical Examination.

9. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**

No application is required to be submitted in this regard. The recruitment shall be on open rally system. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board on the dates and time prescribed above. Candidates will have to undergo the following test :

a) **HEIGHT BAR**

At the very beginning, candidates will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will be eliminated and will not be allowed to participate in further process of recruitment and will be given rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

b) **5 Kms Race (Qualifying Nature)**

Those candidates who qualify the height bar will be subjected to 5 Kms race to be completed in 24 minutes.

Note:-

The candidate (s) who do not qualify the 5 Kms race will be eliminated and will not be allowed to participate in further process of recruitment and will be given rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

c) **Identification of candidate**

The candidates who have qualified the 5 Kms race will be subjected to the modern biometrics methods at each stage of recruitment to obviate impersonation by the candidates. (In the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression digital photograph and any specifying identifying mark in the body will be used).

d) **Screening of testimonials**

Original testimonial/documents of the candidates will be checked after the identification process is completed and only eligible candidates will be permitted to the next stage of the recruitment. Candidates who fail to produce requisite testimonials/certificates will be eliminated from the recruitment process and in no case will be allowed provisionally. Candidates being considered for vacancies reserved categories i.e. SC, ST and OBC should produced caste certificate in proforma as prescribed in **Annexure-I & II**.

e) **Physical Measurement**

The candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened for height, chest and weight by the board of officers. The candidates who meet the requirement of physical standard will be allowed to participate in Physical Efficiency Test and candidates who do not fulfill the laid down physical standard will be eliminated from participating in the further process of recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection. Any dispute in measurement will be settled by the Presiding Officer on the Spot whose order will be final.

f) **Physical Efficiency Test**

The Physical Efficiency Test will consist of following **qualifying nature events:-**

- i) 11 feet long jump (3 chances will be given).
- ii) 3 feet 6 inches high jump (3 chances will be given).

Note:-

A candidate must qualify in all the above events. Failure to qualify in any of the above events of PET will render the candidate disqualified to appear in subsequent process of the recruitment by giving rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

g) **Trade Test**

The candidates who qualify in the P.E.T. will be tested in trade/job efficiency by a Board of Officers.

h) **WRITTEN EXAMINATION (100 MARKS)**

I. The candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test and found proficient in Technical/Trade Test will be required to appear in a written test.

II The written test will be of one hour and 30 minutes duration and comprise of two parts with maximum of 100 marks, wherein 50 Marks will be allotted for descriptive test viz. essay/letter writing of about 100 words in Hindi or English and descriptive questions to test General Awareness and environment and remaining 50 Marks for objective test consisting of questions based on General knowledge, Science Numerical Aptitude, Test of reasoning etc.

III. The question paper of the written test will consist of questions on General Awareness, General Knowledge, Knowledge of elementary Mathematics, ability to observe and distinguish pattern and to test the basic knowledge of candidate in English/Hindi. The paper can be answered either in Hindi or English. The written test will be held after PET/Trade Test is over.

IV Answers should be marked/written with Ball pen only.

i) There will be no interview for this recruitment.

j) **MEDICAL EXAMINATION:-**

i. Candidates who qualify the PST/PET, Trade Test and written examination and find place in merit list will be put through detailed Medical Examination, to assess their suitability/fitness for appointment. There will be nothing like temporary unfit. However, unfit candidates can be re-examined for which they have to prefer an appeal within 15 days from the date of rejection. Cost of Chest X-ray and Pathological test will be borne by the candidates.

Note :- Candidates equal to the number of vacancies in each category and normal anticipated failures as per the past experience will be called for medical examination. Even if there is a shortfall, no further round of medical examination will be conducted. Unfilled vacancies will remain as shortfall.

ii. **Appeal against Medical Examination:-**

If a candidate is declared unfit for appointment in CRPF during Medical Examination, grounds for rejection will be communicated to him in broad terms by the Medical Officer duly countersigned by the Presiding Officer. The candidates, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal for review medical examination with a proof of his fitness in the form of a medical certificate as given in Annexure-IV from a Registered Medical Practitioner, to the name of (Appellate Authority) i.e. **Dy. Inspector General of Police, Group Centre, CRPF, Pinjore, Distt Panchkula, Haryana**. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the Registered Medical Practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer for appointment in CRPF. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee **of Rs. 25/- (Rupees twenty five only)** through IPO/Banker's Cheque/Demand Draft in the name of the Appellate Authority as mentioned above and the same should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate.

k) **FINAL SELECTION :-**

- i. The final selection of the candidate will be made in order of merit in each category.
- ii. The cut off percentage of marks for appointment will be as under:-

General and Ex servicemen	:	35 %
SC/ST/OBC	:	33 %
- iii. During the recruitment process, decision of the Recruitment Board shall be final.

10. The following documents in original should be brought by the candidate at the time of recruitment:-

- i) Matriculation (SSLC) certificate for proof of Educational qualification and Date of Birth.

- ii) SC/ST and OBC certificate, as applicable, issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar which should be on the format as prescribed in Annexure-I & II respectively. Caste certificate which are not in the prescribed proforma as in Annexure-I & II will not be accepted.
- iii) Original Technical/Trade/Professional and experience certificates.
- iv) Discharge certificate in case of Ex-Servicemen.
- v) Other certificates in support of additional qualification i.e. NCC/Scout & guides/sports/proficiency in computer if any.
- vi) No objection certificate in case of persons serving in Govt./Semi Government Departments /Undertakings etc.
- vii) Four recent passport size photographs of the candidates.
- viii) Hillman or Tribesman certificates which should be in the format as prescribed in Annexure-III (If belongs to any of the category and desires to avail relaxation in height as prescribed for such category).

11. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS** :-

- i) Candidates will have to appear for selection/test at their own expenses and no TA/DA will be admissible. They will also have to make their own arrangements for stay during recruitment which may continue for 6 to 7 days. Candidates are advised to bring their own pen/pencil etc.
- ii) The Department will not be responsible for any accident/injuries etc. if any, sustained during the course of recruitment process/test.
- iii) Education Certificate, testimonials, documents in original are required at the time of recruitment process. Candidates not producing original documents shall be rejected at the initial stage itself.
- iv) The candidates shall have to bring with them writing materials for Written Test.
- v) The candidates selected for appointment shall be subjected to Chest X-Ray & Pathological test in the presence of CRPF Medical Officer or in the presence of an authorized official, at their own cost.
- vi) Undergoing medical examination at the end of the recruitment process does not guarantee of appointment as the offer of appointment will be made only, according to allotted vacancies from the merit list in the order of seniority of the candidates.
- vii) Selected candidates on their appointment in CRPF will be governed by the CRPF Act 1949, CRPF Rules 1955 and other Central Government Rules and regulations as applicable from time to time.

- viii) All the posts are combatised and are purely temporary but likely to be continued. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India or outside.
- ix) Canvassing in any form or bringing outside influence will automatically disqualify the candidate from appearing the tests.
- x) No prior application is required to be submitted in this regard. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board at Group Centre, CRPF, Pinjore, Distt- Panchkula, Haryana.
- xi) Vacancies can be altered/changed/increased /decreased due to administrative reasons.
- xii) After the selection/appointment, if any candidate is found ineligible or guilty or suppressing facts on any ground at any time, before, during or after his selection/appointment, his services will be terminated without assigning any reason.
- xiii) The candidate joining post will have to undergo prescribed basic training at training institutions of CRPF.
- xiv) Domiciliary Status : - On All India basis.

12. IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES

- i) The recruitment process has a 5 Km run to be completed in 24 minutes. This requires endurance and stamina. Candidates are advised to practice for the races before coming for recruitment, they are further advised to get themselves medically examined regarding their suitability to run the specified distance in the given time. CRPF will not be responsible for any injury/mishap or medical problem which may arise from the race or other events of the recruitment process.
- ii) Be aware of Touts. No money is charged for recruitment in CRPF. If you have paid or promised to pay money to any one, you are cheated, you are losing money. If any one demands money or promise recruitment, immediately inform the Presiding Officer (P.O.) of recruitment Board.
