RECRUITMENT OF CONSTABLE (DAFTRY/PEON/SK(Min)/FARASH) IN C.R.P.F.

1. Recruitment for the posts of Constable (Daftry/Peon/Safai Karamchari (M)/Farash) from the states of HP, Punjab, Chandigarh (UT) and J&K will be carried out at Group Centre, CRPF, PO-Sarai Khas, Kartarpur, Jalandhar (Punjab) w.e.f 16/8/2010 as per details given hereunder:-

- Note :- (i) Number of Vacancies released/notified may vary later on administrative grounds without assigning any reason.
(ii) Recruitment will be limited to the candidates of HP, Punjab, Chandigarh (UT) and J&K states only.
(iii) Registration of candidates and issue of registration slips for all above posts will be held w.e.f. 16/8/2010 from 0900 hrs to 1700 hrs at Group Centre, CRPF, Sarai Khas, Jalandhar, (Punjab).

2. The post carries pay scale of Pay Band-1 i.e. Rs. 5200-20200 with Grade pay Rs. 2000/- p.m.
3. **Other allowances:** - As admissible to Central Govt. employees from time to time under the rules.
4. **Place of duty:-** Any where within as well as outside the Territory of India.
5. New Contributory Pension scheme to Central Govt. employees which has come into effect from 01/01/2004 will be applicable to all selected candidates.

6. Ward (s) of serving CRPF personnel may also appear, if so desire accordingly. They will be required to compete with other normal candidates. Ward(s) of serving CRPF personnel may appear either from their home State or from the State in which his father/mother is posted/deployed or concerned GC of the BN of Father/Mother at the time of recruitment. The Wards of CRPF serving personnel will have to produce an undertaking to be issued by the concerned GCs/BNs that the candidate who is appearing for recruitment is a CRPF ward by giving full details about the Govt. Servant to avoid any bogus entry in the recruitment.

7. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR CT(DAFTRY)/(PEON/SK(M)/FARASH) ARE AS UNDER:**

A) Educational Qualification :

- i) Matriculation or 10th class passed from a recognized board/university.
- ii) The candidates should be registered with their concerned employment exchanges and they will have to produce registration card and No. at the time of recruitment.
- iii) Should be bonafide resident of HP/Punjab/Chandigarh(UT)/J&K State.

B) Age : 18--25 years (cut off date for age will be 1/8/2010 i.e. the last date of sponsoring candidates by the Employment Exchanges.)

- i) Relaxation in upper age limit as under :-

SC/ST	- 5 years
OBC	- 3 years
Govt servants	- Up to the age of 40 years in the case of general candidates and 45 years in case of the SC or the ST in accordance with instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time.
- ii) The children and dependant family members of those who were killed in riots of 1984 would be eligible for relaxation in age by 5 years. If the applicant belongs to SC/ST or OBC category, the relaxation so provided in this clause will be in addition to the age relaxation as applicable in (i) above. To obtain this relaxation a certificate from the concerned District Magistrate of the district where the victim was killed, should be produced.
- iii) In accordance with Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension (Deptt. Of Personnel & Training) GOI Notification No. 15012/7/1991-ESTT(D) dated 6/12/2005, age relaxation of 5 years in the upper age limit will be provided to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 1/1/1980 to 31/12/1989. Candidate intending to avail above relaxation has to produce required certificate issued by the following authorities:-
 - a) The District Magistrate within whose jurisdiction he had ordinarily resided.
 - b) Any other authority designated in this behalf by the Govt of Jammu and Kashmir.

C) **Physical measurement/PET**

The candidates should be physically fit in all respects. The candidates should be able to complete one mile race in 10 minutes.

D) **Medical Standard:-**

The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect that is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

Should be 6/6 right and 6/12 left eye or 6/9 both eyes without any optical devices.

E) **RELAXATION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN**

Ex-servicemen who have served regularly in Army, Navy, Air Force of the Indian Union and retired, discharged from service are eligible. Age concession for Ex-servicemen will be allowed in accordance with the orders issued by Govt from time to time and they will be allowed to deduct Military service from their actual age and such resultant age should not exceed the prescribed age limit by more than 03 years as provided in DOP&T Notification No. 39016/10/79/-R(Est© dated 15/12/79. Break in service should not be more than 24 months. Ex-servicemen who were discharged from Army at their own request before completing five(5) years of service will not be eligible for recruitment.

8. **SELECTION PROCESS:-**

No application is required to be submitted in this regard. The recruitment shall be on open rally system. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board on the date and time prescribed above. Candidates will have to undergo the following test:-

a) **01 Mile Race (Qualifying Nature)**

Candidates will be subjected to one mile race to be completed in 10 minutes.

Note:-

The candidate (s) who will not qualify the one mile race will be eliminated and will not be allowed to participate in further process of recruitment and will be issued a rejection slip intimating reasons for rejection.

b) **Identification of candidate**

The candidates who have qualified the one mile race will be subjected to the modern biometric methods at each stage of recruitment to obviate impersonation by the candidates. (In the absence of computer based biometric equipments, thumb impression digital photograph and any specifying identifying mark in the body will be used).

c) **Screening of testimonials**

Original testimonial/documents of the candidates will be checked after the identification process is completed and only eligible candidates will be permitted to the next stage of the recruitment. Candidates who fail to produce requisite testimonials/certificates will be eliminated from the recruitment process and in no case will be allowed provisionally. Candidates being considered for vacancies of reserved categories i.e. SC, ST and OBC should produce caste certificate in proforma as prescribed in **Annexure-I & II**.

d) **Trade Test**

The candidate who qualify in one mile race will be tested in trade/job efficiency by the Board of Officers for the post he has appeared and test will be conducted according to the job nature of the post.

e) **MEDICAL EXAMINATION:-**

- i. Candidates who qualify one mile race and Trade Test and find place in merit list will be put through detailed Medical Examination, to assess their suitability/fitness for appointment. There will be nothing like temporary unfit. Cost of Chest X-ray and Pathological test will be borne by the candidates.

Note :- Candidates equal to the number of vacancies in each category and normal anticipated failures as per the past experience will be called for medical examination. Even if there is a shortfall, no further round of medical examination will be conducted. Unfilled vacancies will remain as shortfall.

ii. **Appeal against Medical Examination:-**

If a candidate is declared unfit for appointment in CRPF during Medical Examination, grounds for rejection will be communicated to him in broad terms by the Medical Officer duly countersigned by the Presiding Officer. The candidates, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal for review medical examination with a proof of his fitness in the form of a medical certificate as given in Annexure-III from a Registered Medical Practitioner, to the name of (Appellate Authority) i.e. **Dy. Inspector General of Police, Group Centre, CRPF, Sarai Khas, Kartarpur, Jalandhar, (Punjab)**. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the Registered Medical Practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer for appointment in CRPF. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains medical re-examination fee of **Rs. 25/- (Rupees twenty five only)** through IPO/Banker's Cheque/Demand Draft in the name of the Appellate Authority as mentioned above and the same should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate.

f) **FINAL SELECTION :-**

- i. The final selection of the candidate will be made in order of merit in each category. Merit will be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in the proficiency test of particular job/post.
- ii. The cut off percentage of marks for appointment will be as under:-

General and Ex servicemen	: 35 %
SC/ST/OBC	: 33 %
- iii. During the recruitment process, decision of the Recruitment Board shall be final.

The following documents in original should be brought by the candidate at the time of recruitment:-

- i) Matriculation (SSLC) certificate for proof of Educational qualification and Date of Birth.
- ii) SC/ST and OBC certificate, as applicable, issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar which should be on the format as prescribed in Annexure-I & II respectively. Caste certificate which are not in the prescribed proforma as in Annexure-I & II will not be accepted.
- iii) Original Registration Card of employment exchange.
- iv) Domicile certificate issued by designated authority of the concerned state to prove the domiciliary status.
- v) Discharge certificate in case of Ex-Servicemen.
- vi) No objection certificate in case of persons serving in Govt./Semi Government Departments /Undertakings etc.
- vii) Four recent passport size photographs of the candidates.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS :-

- i) Candidates will have to appear for selection/test at their own expenses and no TA/DA will be admissible. They will also have to make their own arrangements for stay during recruitment which may continue for 6 to 7 days. Candidates are advised to bring their own pen/pencil etc.
- ii) The Department will not be responsible for any accident/injuries etc. if any, sustained during the course of recruitment process/test.
- iii) Education Certificate, testimonials, documents in original are required at the time of recruitment process. Candidates not producing original documents shall be rejected.
- iv) The candidates selected for appointment shall be subjected to Chest X-Ray & Pathological test in the presence of CRPF Medical Officer or in the presence of an authorized official, at their own cost.
- v) Undergoing medical examination at the end of the recruitment process does not guarantee the appointment as the offer of appointment will be made only according to allotted vacancies from the merit list in the order of seniority of the candidates.
- vi) Selected candidates on their appointment in CRPF will be governed by the CRPF Act 1949, CRPF Rules 1955 and other Central Government Rules and regulations as applicable from time to time.

- vii) All the posts are combatised and are purely temporary but likely to be continued. Selected candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in India or outside.
- viii) Canvassing in any form or bringing outside influence will automatically disqualify the candidate from appearing the tests.
- ix) No prior application is required to be submitted in this regard. Willing/eligible candidates should appear before the Recruitment Board at Group Centre, CRPF, Sarai Khas, Jalandhar (Punjab).
- x) After the selection/appointment, if any candidate is found ineligible or guilty of suppressing facts on any ground at any time, before, during or after his selection/appointment, his services will be terminated without assigning any reason.
- xi) The candidate joining post will have to undergo prescribed basic training at training institutions of CRPF.

11. **IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES**

- i) The recruitment process has one mile race to be completed in 10 minutes. This requires endurance and stamina. Candidates are advised to practice for the race before coming for recruitment; they are further advised to get themselves medically examined regarding their suitability to run the specified distance in the given time. CRPF will not be responsible for any injury/mishap or medical problem which may arise from the race or other events of the recruitment process.
- ii) Be aware of Touts. No money is charged for recruitment in CRPF. If you have paid or promised to pay money to any one, you are cheated, you are losing money. If any one demands money or promise recruitment, immediately inform the Presiding Officer (P.O.) of Recruitment Board.
